Minutes of the **Executive Committee meeting** of the Anatomical Society of India, held on 26th **December, 2012** at 6.00 pm in the conference hall of Kalinga Institute of Dental Sciences, **Bhubaneswar** during 60th annual conference (Diamond Jubilee Conference) of ASI.

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Vasanti V. Arole, the President of ASI

- Min 1/12 The members were informed about the sad demise of the following anatomists: (1) Dr. P.L. Jahagirdar (Miraj), (ii) Dr. M.P. Singh (Bhopal), (iii) Dr. Prakash (Bangalore), (iv) Dr. S.K. Verma (Jabalpur), (v) Dr. A.K. Arora (Agra) & (vi) Dr. A.B. Gubbi (Gulbarga). Members stood in silence for two minutes to pray to Almighty to grant peace to the departed souls and to provide strength to the members of the bereaved families to bear this irreparable loss. The General Secretary was requested to send condolence messages to members of the bereaved families.
- Min 2/12. The minutes of the executive committee meeting held on 26th December, 2011 during 59th National conference of ASI held at Sri Aurobindo Medical College & Postgraduate Institute, Indore, were confirmed & approved with following modification (adding): Proposal of Dr. Ashok Sahai to add Medical Education as one of the subjects in the schedule of subjects in the appendix of Rules & Regulations of ASI, approved in E.C. meeting, held on 26.12.2011, at Indore.

- Min 3/12. Regarding matters arising from last executive committee meeting. The General Secretary Informed:-
 - (i) Life time achievement award in memory of Dr Inderjit Dewan:- An emergency E.C. meeting was called by circulation & E-mail on request of the President Dr. Vasanti V. Arole to approve one name for this award for 2012 out of 3 names recommended by the search committee. All the E.C. members unanimously approved the name of Dr. Mahdi Hasan. Executive Committee members also permitted to communicate the decision to him, subject to approval by the General Body of ASI. This was communicated to Dr. Mahdi Hasan (Lucknow) in writing through Dr. A. K. Srivastava.
 - (ii) Fellowship of ASI: The constituted selection committee chairman Dr. Mahdi Hasan forwarded 50 names of founder fellows which he received from nominated members of selection committee from each of the five zones: South zone 13, central zone-14, West zone-08, East zone 05 & North zone-10. The 50 names of founder fellows were read & approved. Rules & regulations of fellowship were read & approved. The format of nomination form for the fellowship was also approved.
- Min 4/12. The names of 180 new life members & 216 new ordinary members were approved for 2012.
- **Min 5/12:** Recommendations of the **Editorial Board meeting** held on 26.12.12 at 4.30 pm. were presented by the Editor as given below:
 - (i) It was decided to publish the journal by Elsevier or any other publishing house whosoever is economical & will take care of indexing of the Journal. The new editor will finalise it.
 - (ii) A tentative budget of Rs. 10 Lac was approved for it.
 - (iii) The term of contract (MOU) will be approved by the President, the General Secretary & the Treasurer with legal advice before it is finalised. For this, they will meet at a common place for which TA will be reimbursed to them.
 - (iv) If required, change post of Editor to post of Editor-in-Chief & he will be authorised to pick six National / International subject experts as Editors.
 - (v) Audited income & expenditure account for the financial year 2011-12 & account from April 2012 to December 2012 with a deficit of Rs. 42418/- and Rs. 25000/-. It was approved.
- **Min 6/12:** (i) Audited receipt and payment account for the period 1.4.2011 to 31.3.2012 was presented by the Treasurer Dr. A.K. Srivastava which **was approved.**
 - (ii) Treasurer informed that income tax registration of the society has been done & PAN no. AACAA3859L has been allotted.
 - (iii) Society has been granted exemption under 12 A from the FY 2011-12 onwards. For this purpose new balance sheets have been prepared for earlier years. The matter of IT exemption for earlier year is before IT commissioner, Lucknow. For IT work a some of Rs. 1,60000/- has been spent so far.
 - (iv) New charted accountant M/S Asutosh Gupta & Associates have been appointed. They will try that life membership subscription be considered as a corpus fund.
 - (v) M/S Surinder Kohli & Associates were appointed as I.T. consultant & they will charge a professional fees of Rs. 25000/, per annum, for all I.T. concerned work of the society including filing of Income Tax return.
 - (vi) Executive Committee thanked Dr. A.K. Srivastava, Dr. Punita Manik & Dr. Ashok Sahai and other concerned persons for their help to get this great job done.
- Min 7/12: a) Following were appointed judges for different awards of the society on published papers in the Journal of Anatomical Society of India, 2012 (Vol 61). These names shall remain confidential.

- d) Members for the selection committee for awardee of Dr. S.P. Jain Memorial Oration 2013 were appointed (Names are confidential). The selection committee was empowered to choose the name other than the names considered earlier. The orator should be sent an invitation, a copy of rules & regulations and the orator will also be requested to send the topic of his / her Oration to the General Secretary.

- e) Search committee was constituted for life time achievement award for 2013. **The names are confidential.**
- f) Selection committee was constituted for 3 years (vide rule no. 8 of fellowship rules and regulations) for selection of fellows.

- (i) **Dr. Mahdi Hasan** (Lucknow) was awarded Padamshree by the President of India on 26th January 2012. He is the first Anatomists to have received this award.
- (ii) Dr. S. Ramaswamy (Chennai) was awarded Fellowship of Anatomical Society (FAS) of Great Britain & Ireland.
- (iii) **Dr. Gayatri Rath** (New-Delhi) was awarded 1st prize for the best article published in the Journal of International Medical Science Academy for the year 2011.

Dewan Centenary life time achievement award" to Prof. I.B. Singh (Rohtak). Three plenary lectures were delivered by Dr. C.Anand, Dr. J.M. Kaul & Dr. Gayatri Rath.

(v) **Karnataka State Chapter**:14th Annual Conference of the chapter was held at Bijapur on 7th, 8th & 9th September 2012. Number of CMEs were held at various colleges on Genetics, Yoga & Clinical, Anatomy etc. They are publishing "Anatomica Karnataka".

 - (iii) Proposal of **Dr. Naresh Chandra** (Lucknow) duly seconded by Dr. Vishram Singh (Ghaziabad), regarding institution of an **award in the name of late "Dr Manju Naresh Memorial Gold Medal" for the best poster presentation** in the National conference of ASI in the field of Histology. Rules & regulations will be framed on the line of other award with the condition: (a) No age limit; (b) Presenter has to be a regular valid member for at least 2 years / life member, & (c) A certificate certifying, that poster has not been presented in any other conference. This certificate with title of the poster will be sent to the General Secretary by 30th September, with a copy to the Organising Secretary.
