Members stood in silence for two minutes to pray to the Almighty to grant peace to the departed soul and to provide strength to the members of the bereaved families to bear this irreparable loss.

Min. 1/17 : Members acknowledged the receipt of the minutes of the last General Body meeting held on 30th November, 2016, which were circulated vide No. ASI/17-Min.(ii) / Secy-6 dated 24th January,2017. **Minutes were approved with the modification in Min.7/16(1) d: modification of city:-** Dr. Anand Misra (Varanasi) in place of Lucknow and Dr. Subhash K. Deshpande (Dharwad) in place of Bangalore.

Min. 3/17 : Members were apprised of the decision of the Executive Committee meeting held on 30th November, 2017 at Pt. J.N.M. Medical College, Raipur.

 - (iv) General Secretary in conjunction with Editor-in-Chief will give a notice of termination of MOU to M/S Reed Elsevier, the publisher of JASI in May/June 2018 i.e. at least 6 month prior to **expiry of current MOU.**
 - (v) Mr. D. Krishna Chaitanya Reddy of Department of Anatomy, Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad was appointed as Joint Editor in place of Dr. Ruchira Sethi as she has left the Santosh Medical college.
 - (vi) The budget for the year 2018 remains the same as for 2017 i.e. Rs 15 Lakh only.
 - (vii) All the Editorial Board members are once again requested to send three or more names of proactive and sincere academicians for inclusion in the panel of Editorial Board members.
 - (viii) The corresponding author of each published paper and each reviewer of JASI can download himself / herself (with EVISE username) a certificate of excellence from Elsevier with its logo.
 - (ix) To maintain high standards, the reviewing and editing process has become more stringent and authors of the research / review articles are requested to be extra careful in preparation of the manuscript for publication.


Min.12/17 : In any matter with permission of Chair:


