The meeting was called to order by Dr. N. Damayanti Devi, the President of ASI.

**Obituary:** Members were informed about the sad demise of fellow anatomists: Dr. I. Manorama Thomas (Bangalore), Dr. (Mrs.) Molly M. Paul (Ludhiana), Dr. T. S. Rangathan (Chennai), Dr. Sitendu Bose (Indore) & Dr. S. H. M. Abdi (Lucknow). Members stood in silence for two minutes to pray to the Almighty to grant peace to the departed soul and to provide strength to the members of the bereaved families to bear this irreparable loss.

**Min. 1/16 :** Members acknowledged the receipt of the minutes of the last General Body meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2015, which were circulated vide No. ASI/16-Min. (ii)/ Secy-12 dated 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2016. **Minutes were approved with the modification** that after 3/15 (a)xii—the Executive Committee be read as Editorial Board meeting.

**Min. 2/16:** In the matters arising out of the minutes of last General Body meeting:

- a) A representation regarding **reduction of faculty** in medical colleges for teaching and training of MBBS students in Anatomy in existing and proposed medical colleges in the country to 4 faculty for 150 students, was sent by the General Secretary of ASI to Dr. Jaishree Mehta, President of MCI who was requested to restore teacher-student ratio of 1:10 i.e. for 100 students there should be 5 faculty and 5 demonstrators. Further, since MCI recommends 4 teachers for 240 hours course of teaching in Biochemistry, therefore, there should be at least 12 teachers for 640 hours of teaching in Anatomy. Copy of representation was sent to Hon'ble Prime Minister, Union Health Minister, State Health Minister, Secretary Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India and Secretary MCI.
- b) Dr. Ashok Sahai informed that he has sent his suggestions to the "Parliamentary Committee for Medical Reforms in the Country". An article titled "**Vision article on reforms in Medical Education in India: Challenges and Reforms**" was sent to Additional Director (O&P), Lok Sabha Secretariat with a copy to Hon'ble Prime Minister; the Point no. 5 of the article deals with Teacher-Student ratio. Further he has also sent point-wise comments and the Vision article to the **NITI AYO**G appointed for the drafting National Medical Commission Bill-2016 and later sent a revised Vision article on Medical Education in India: Introspection, Challenges and Reforms" to the **Lodha Committee** requesting him for implementation of suggestions.

**Min.3/16:** **Members were apprised of the decisions of the Executive Committee meeting** held on 28 November, 2016 at All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Jodhpur :-

- (a) **Recommendations of the Editorial Board Meeting** held on 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2016 and approved by the Executive Committee were placed before General Body for ratification:-
  - (i) Audited income and expenditure account of the office of Editor amounting to Rs. 308551=00 for the period 01-04-2015 to 31-03-2016 was presented and **approved**.
  - (ii) Editorial office has achieved the status of self sustaining financial model for internal expenditure.
  - (iii) The budget for the year 2017 remains the same as for 2016 i.e. Rs. 15 Lac only.
  - (iv) Due to current MCI regulations, the on-line issues of the journal have been converted to the print issues. The copy of the issue will be given only to the authors of the published papers in that issue.
  - (v) It was approved that as per MOU the General Secretary in conjunction with Editor-in-Chief, will give a termination notice to the Publisher at least 6 months prior to the expiry of the present MOU (May/June, 2018).
  - (vi) Impact factor has increased as compared to last year i.e. from 0.052 to 0.146 as per Thomas Reuter.
  - (vii) All the Editorial Board members are once again requested to send the names of three or more proactive and sincere academicians for inclusion in the Editorial board panel.
  - (viii) Corresponding author of each published article and each reviewer of JASI will have a certificate of excellence from Elsevier with its logo.
  - (ix) Journal has been included in the list of globally reputed journals of anatomy. **All the above recommendations were ratified by General Body.**
- (b)
  - i) Audited receipt & payment account of Rs.131,31,600=82 for the period 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2016 was presented by Dr. A.K. Srivastava, Treasurer of the Society **was approved**.
  - ii) The Treasurer informed that the Membership renewal of IFFA will be shortly done.
  - iii) Extra expenditure incurred on **website of ASI**: (i) Treasurer informed about online registration for new members with system generated SMS and e-mail about Membership number and receipts to the Member, Gen. Secretary, Treasurer and the Editor in Chief which can be downloaded and printed. This will cost extra expenditure of Rs.10000=00. (ii) For maintenance & editing of website Rs.25000=00 in addition to Rs.4500=00 will have to be paid to the website developing agency every year. **This was approved.**
- (c) **Fellowship Award committee** (i) reconsidered the application of Dr. Prashant E. Natekar and was unanimous in opinion that his application is not in regular format; the committee decided that he be advised to resubmit the application in proper format for consideration of committee in the next meeting. (ii) Members unanimously decided to modify some points and add some criteria for evaluation of Fellowship application (**confidential**). This will be applicable from 2017. **It was approved.**
- (d) General Body was informed that:
  - (i) Judges were appointed for various awards on **published papers** in Journal of ASI for the year 2016 (**Names are confidential**).
  - (ii) Judges were appointed for various **Award Papers** to be presented from dais in award session and poster in award poster session of 2016 (**Names are confidential**).
  - (iii) President Dr. N. Damayanti Devi (Imphal), both Vice President Dr. Ashok Sahai (Agra) and Dr. Gayatri Rath (New Delhi) were nominated as Chairperson & Co-Chairpersons **for Dr. Shamer Singh Memorial Oration** to be delivered by Dr. Mandavi Singh (Varanasi) and also for all the papers to be presented from the dais in **the award session**.
  - (iv) The **Selection Committee** members for award of Dr. S.P. Jain Memorial Oration, 2017 were appointed (**Names are Confidential**).
