Dr (Mrs) Molly M. Paul, MBBS, MS(Anatomy), Ph.D

Dr (Mrs) Molly M. Paul was born on 29th April, 1945 in Kumbanad, Kerala to Late Joseph P. Thomas and Late Annama Joseph Thomas. She grew up in Kumbanad, Kerala and later moved to Bangalore where she did her schooling at Clarence

High School, Bangalore. After her pre-degree, she moved to Christian Medical College and Hospital (CMC), Ludhiana and joined MBBS in 1964. She completed her Masters of Surgery in 1976 in Anatomy under the able guidance of Dr Guy N. Constable. She continued as faculty in the Department of Anatomy and in 1987 was promoted to Professor and later Head of the Department of Anatomy and Human Genetics in CMC, Ludhiana. Her interest in Neuroanatomy motivated her to pursue Ph.D. which was completed in December 2009. She received the Life Time Achievement Award from CMC Alumni in 2005 by the Governor of State of Punjab, and the Founder Fellowship Award from the Anatomical Society of India in 2013. She has to her credit several national and international papers and publications. She was diagnosed with metastatic breast cancer in 2010 and fought the disease bravely for a period of six years. The ever-growing smile on her face in the midst of her physical ailments, her hospitality, her commitment in all the areas of her career, her zeal and enthusiasm were exemplary. It was in God's perfect will to call her peacefully into his presence on January 5th 2016 at 3 pm in Christian Medical College and Hospital, Ludhiana. She is survived by her husband, Mr Madan Paul, Children, Dr Priya, Dr Pearl, Dr Preethi and Dr Vineeth Jaison.
