Prof. Mahdi Hasan was born in 1936. He did MBBS from King George's Medical College, Lucknow, UP in 1958; being **best student-sportsman**, the College Blue of his batch. He did MS with honours from the same institution in 1962. After initial service in the department of Anatomy as Demonstrator and Lecturer in Anatomy he moved to Aligarh as Reader in Anatomy at JN Medical College, AMU, Aligarh. He served in that institution till his retirement in various capacities such as Professor and Chairman, Director- Brain Research Centre, Dean, Principal, Chief Medical Superintendent. After retirement he went back to his alma mater and served there as Senior Research Fellow and Guest Faculty in the Department of Anatomy till he breathed his last in 2013.

He had to his credit more than 100 publications in National and International Journals of repute. As a mark of recognition to his outstanding and innovative research he was awarded many fellowships from national and international academies and delivered a large number of orations. He was advisor to WHO (1983-85) and Visiting Professor to many Universities including University of Gottingen (Germany- 1972), Benghazi, Libya (1983-86), Tehran (1993-94), Nanchang (China 2005).

In recognition of his overall achievements he was conferred with the highest honour of the Anatomical Society of India, "Prof. Inderjit Dewan Life Time Achievement Award of 2012. He was an internationally renowned anatomist, a medical educationist and a pioneering brain researcher. He was recipient of prestigious Dr. BC Roy National Award of MCI (1979), Dr. SS Misra Medal of National Academy of Medical Sciences (India), Dr. Dharam Narayan Memorial Gold Medal of the Anatomical Society of India (1977), Ati Vishistha Chikitsa Medal of College of Chest Physicians of India (1995), Sushruta Award of World Academy of Integrated Medicine (WAIM, 2002), Dr. Tirumurti Award of Indian National Science Academy (2010). And to top everything he was awarded **Padma Shree** in the year 2012 for his distinguished contribution in the development of science in India.
