  - b. Names of the Members of EC (both Office bearers & EC members) who do not attend EC Meeting without informing the Secretary should be mentioned in Minutes of the GB Meeting also and their names forwarded to Returning Officer so that they cannot contest elections for the specified period- Names already mentioned in EC Mitting minutes.

  - d. In the website of ASI where information about affiliated chapters are listed, the data is not updated:- **Update will be done once regular information from state chapters received.**

# 2. Proposal received from Dr G S Jha

- a. Registration Fee: The registration fee of NATCON should be reasonably increased- It was discussed in detail & it was decided that Normal Registration fee for delegates shall be Rs 5000/- & for Postgraduates & associate delegates it shall be 4000/-
- **b.** Nature of NATCON:- It was emphasized that EC members shall take active participation in activities of Society & Conference.

## 3. Proposal from Dr. S L Jethani (General secretary)

- a. 5 workshops / CME can be supported financially up to Rs 150000/ each. Total amount comes to be 750000/-(Seven lakh fifty thousand) only. It should be modified to total amount of Rs 750000/- can be sanctioned for support of workshops/ CME per year with a maximum capping of 150000.--Approved
- b. Financial support to CME/ CME cum Workshop shall be extended toward logistics Only-Approved
- c. Best paper award under Medical education category. Category of award to be clarified- It was

decided that award will be given on published paper. Rules & regulations shall be framed up.

- d. Publication of more articles from India, In Journal of ASI If required number of issues can be increased- **Approved**
- **e. President post** of Society shall be nominated post :- Legal Opinion to be taken before finalization.
- f. There should **be no election for the post of Treasurer**. Executive committee shall have the power to Nominate by minimum 2/3<sup>rd</sup> majority any active life member of Society from Lucknow to look after the duties of treasurer for the period of 3 years:- Legal Opinion to be taken.
- g. There should not be any free registration: It was decided that present practice of free registration for the life member delegates who are above 70 years shall remain as such, Society will reimburse 50% of registration fee to the conference organizers once they submit detail with name & life member registration number.

Min.22-EC/24: At the end General Secretary thanked all the office bearers, to Dr. R K Verma for helping treasurer & to Dr Jitendra Patel for helping to secretory office & to Dr. Vishram Singh for maintaining high International standard of Journal, to the members of the Executive committee for their co- operation and help given to him as and when required. He also thanked the invited members for their valuable suggestions and help. He gave special thanks to Dr. Punita Manik treasure, for maintaining the accounts of society meticulously.
